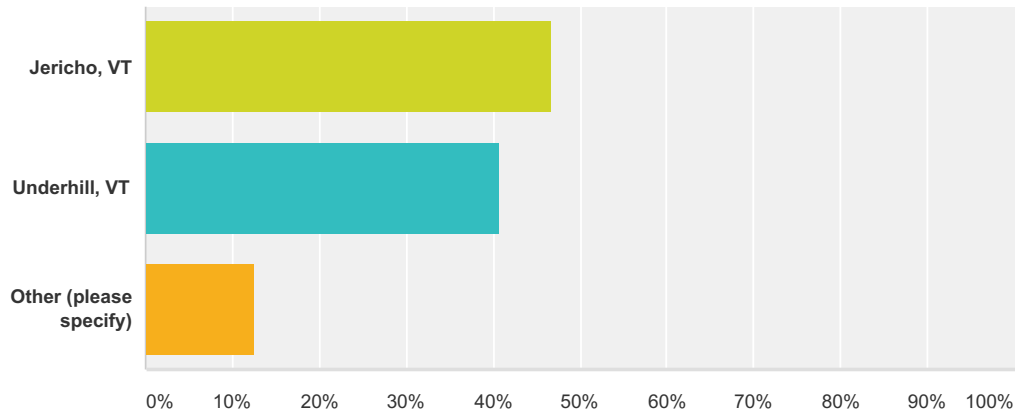

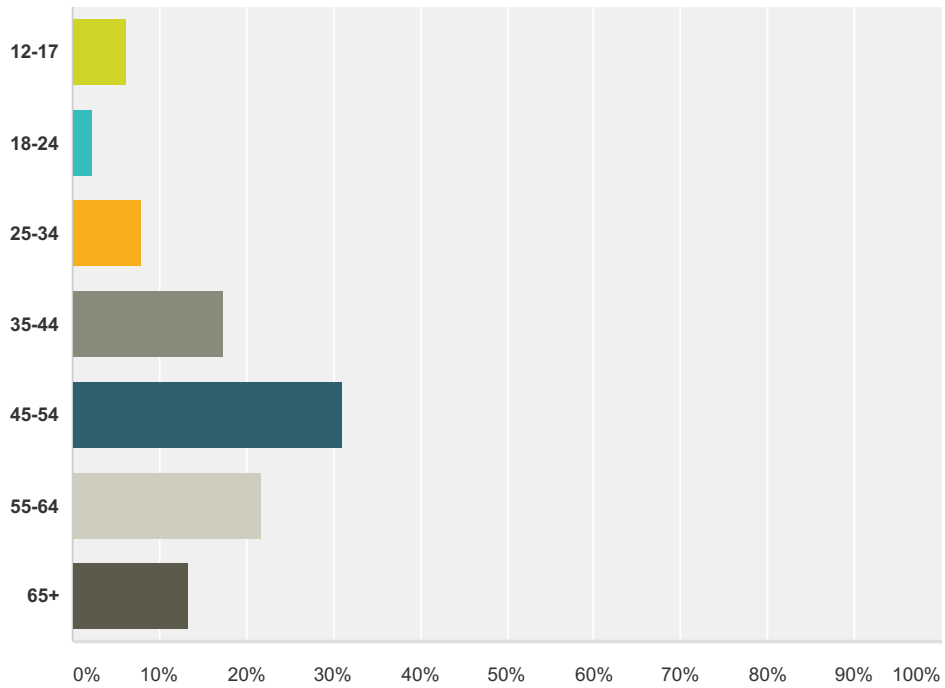

Q2 Please select your age group:

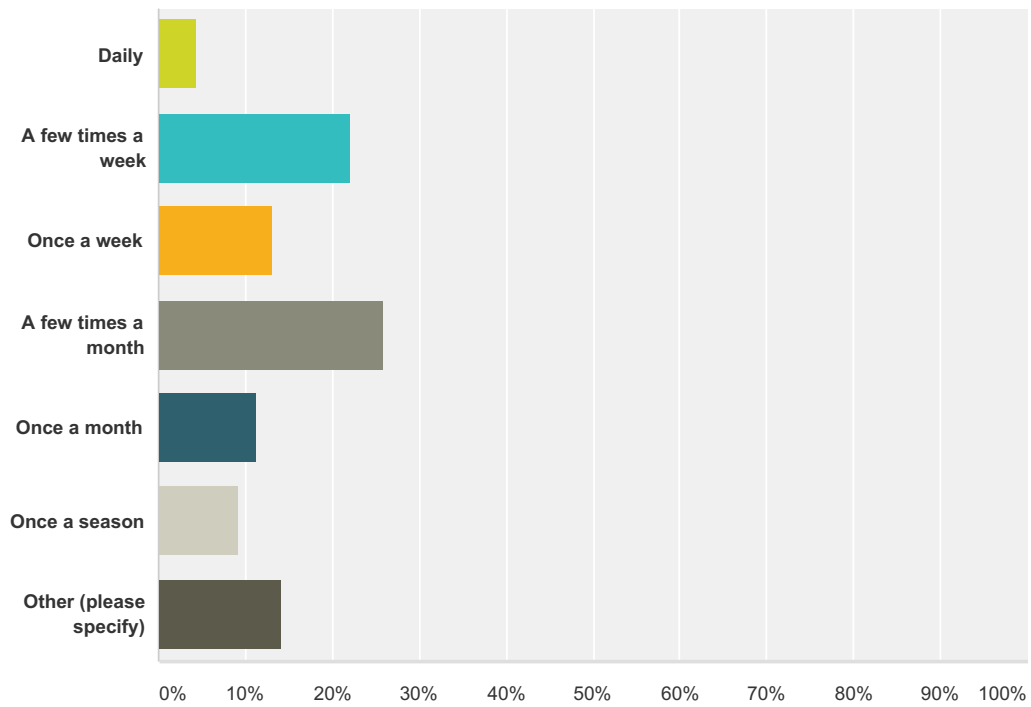

Q3 How often do you visit Mills Riverside Park?

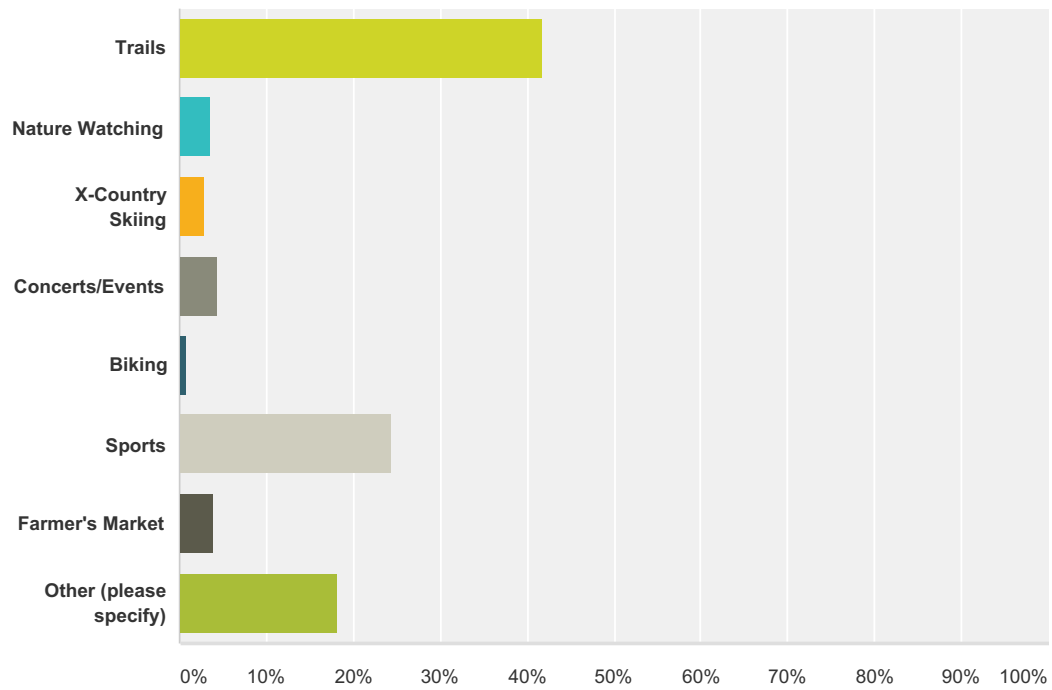

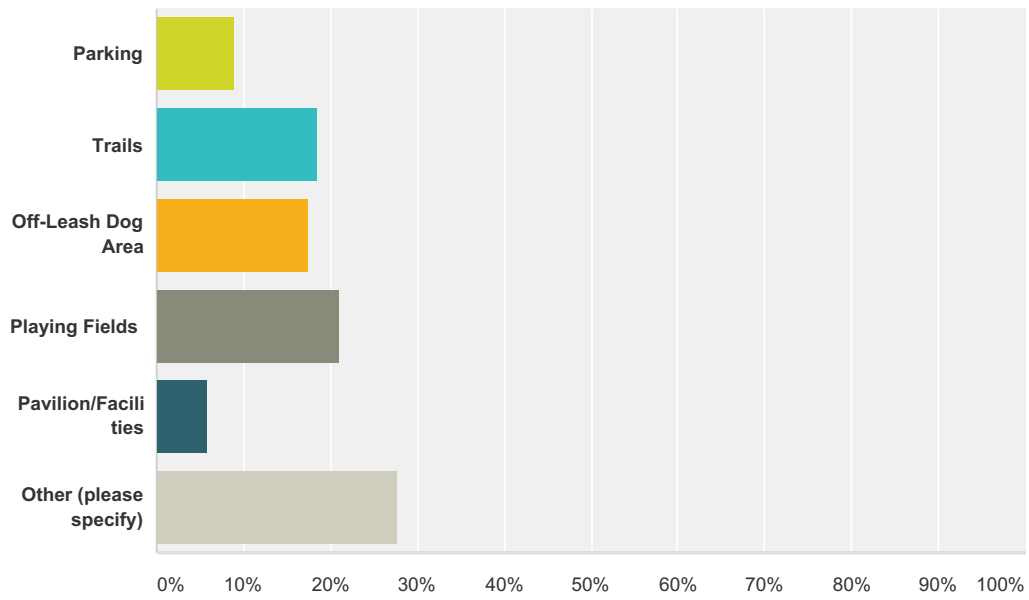

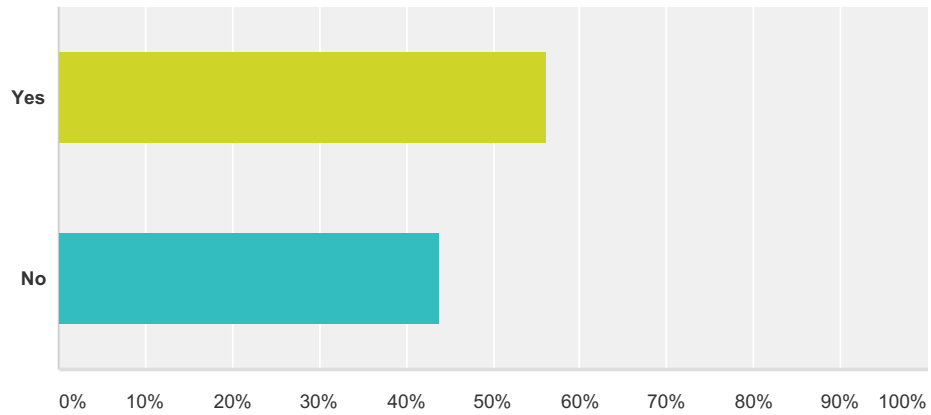

Q8 Do you bring your dog(s) to the park?

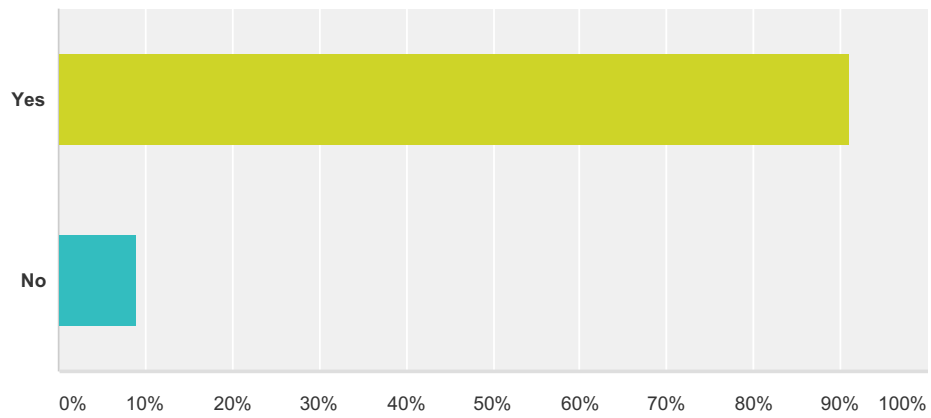
